BECOME A LEARNING COACH

Becoming a Learning Coach is the entry point to becoming a certified National Trainer and is accessible to anyone employed by a Boys & Girls Clubs. Learning Coaches must be enrolled in Spillet Leadership University (SLU) and be committed to supporting the professional development of other staff at their organization.

LEARNING MODULES

After completing the Learning Coaches curriculum, individuals gain access to Learning Modules which focus on the basic skills and knowledge front-line staff need to create optimal Club Experiences for young people. The length and single topic focus make them ideal for use during staff meetings, trainings, and retreats. Learning Modules also provide a way by which staff can easily reconcile attendance of required safety courses.

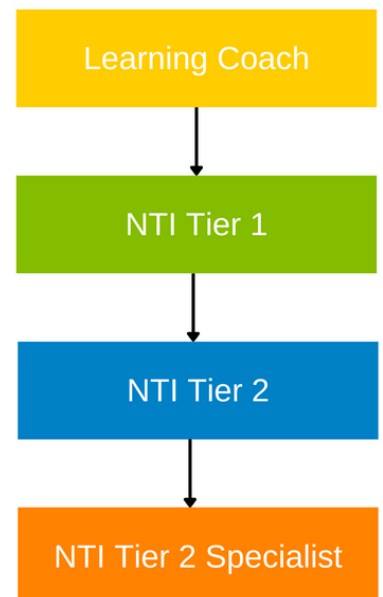
ELIGIBILITY & REGISTRATION
